# Manasvi Merit Scholarships Guidelines 2019

### 2019 Poor and Merit Scholarship Programme (MSEP 2019)

#### **Student's Marks Criteria:**

#### **Basic rules**

Student should have an aggregate of 80% marks from 10th class to the current year of the course of study. The scholarship is awarded for the 2018-19 academic year, the marks from 10<sup>th</sup> class through the 2017-18 academic years are considered for selection.

- 1. 2018-19 academic year in 1sst Year Intermediate 80% in 10th Class
- 2. 2018-19 academic year in 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Intermediate 80% in 1<sup>st</sup> year Intermediate and 10<sup>th</sup> Class.
- 3. 2018-19 academic year 1<sup>st</sup> Year of 3 yr or 4 yr Degree like BSc, BCom, Engineering, MCA 80% in Intermediate and 10<sup>th</sup> Class.
- 4. 2018-19 academic year 2<sup>nd</sup> Year of 3 yr or 4 yr Degree like BSc, BCom, Engineering, MCA 80% in 1<sup>st</sup> year of the course, 80% in Intermediate and 80% in 10<sup>th</sup> Class.
- 5. 208-19 academic year 3<sup>rd</sup> Year of 3 yr or 4 yr Degree like BSc, BCom, Engineering, MCA 70% in 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the course or Aggregate of 80% in 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year combined, 70% in Intermediate and 70% in 10<sup>th</sup> Class.
- 6. 2018-19 academic year 4<sup>th</sup> Year of degree like B Pharmacy/Engineering 80% in 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the course or Aggregate of 70% in 1<sup>st</sup> year, 2<sup>nd</sup> year and 3<sup>rd</sup> year combined, 80% in Intermediate and 80% in 10<sup>th</sup> Class.
- 7. 2018-19 academic year 1<sup>st</sup> year of Medicine: 70% in Intermediate and 70% in 10<sup>th</sup> Class.
- 8. 2018-19 academic year 2<sup>nd</sup> year of Medicine: 60% in 1<sup>st</sup> year, 70% in Intermediate and 70% in 10<sup>th</sup> Class.
- 9. 2018-19 academic year 3<sup>rd</sup> year of Medicine: 60% in 2<sup>nd</sup> year or Aggregate of 60% in 1<sup>st</sup> year and 2<sup>nd</sup> year combined

10. 2018-19 academic year 4<sup>th</sup> year of Medicine: 60% in 3<sup>rd</sup> year or Aggregate of 60% in 1<sup>st</sup> year, 2<sup>nd</sup> year and 3<sup>rd</sup> year combined

11. CA/ICWA/MBA/Any other Master courses – Approval by Executive Committee based on the situation.

### **Financial Criteria:**

Family Income (Both parents combined income) should not exceed Rs 3,00,000.00 (Income certificate or White ration card needs to be submitted)

#### **Scholarship amount 2019**

Rs. 2000- Rs. 5000 /- to all students who is meeting Qualifying criteria
